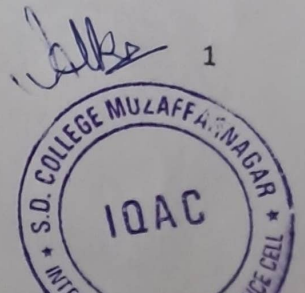
## Action taken Report of Best Practices for Even Semester

( 2025-26 )

Under the Legacy of Vidya Bharti Uchcha Shiksha Sansthan, Meerut Prant, the institution successfully participated in the Bharat Baudhik Indian Knowledge System (IKS) Examination organized under the guidance and legacy of Vidya Bharti Uchcha Shiksha Sansthan, Meerut Prant. The examination aimed to promote awareness and understanding of Indian culture, heritage, traditional knowledge systems, and national values among students. To ensure maximum participation, awareness campaigns, orientation sessions, and motivational interactions were conducted within the institution. Faculty members encouraged students to actively register and participate in the examination. Study materials and guidance sessions were also provided to help students prepare effectively.

As a result of these efforts, a total of **1583 students** registered for the Bharat Baudhik IKS Examination, reflecting enthusiastic participation and keen interest among students towards Indian Knowledge Systems and cultural heritage. The institution is proud to report that **five students were selected for prizes** based on their outstanding performance in the examination. Their achievement has brought recognition to the institution and inspired other students to actively engage in such knowledge-oriented and value-based academic activities. The successful implementation of this initiative has strengthened awareness regarding India's rich intellectual and cultural traditions among students. It has also contributed positively towards value-based education, national consciousness, and holistic personality development. The institution remains committed to promoting similar academic and cultural initiatives in the future for the overall intellectual and moral development of students.

One day National Seminar was successfully organized on 27 January 2026 under the guidance of the Bharatiya Bhasha Samiti, Ministry of Education. The seminar aimed to promote awareness regarding Indian languages, culture, and the Indian Knowledge System among students and academicians. The program was inaugurated in the presence of distinguished guests including Prof. Vimala Y., Vice Chancellor, along with other eminent academicians and educationists. Experts delivered insightful lectures emphasizing the role of Indian languages in preserving knowledge, culture, ethics, and national unity. Discussions were conducted on linguistic diversity, cultural integration, Developed India @2047, and the preservation of Indian knowledge traditions. The total of 54 faculty members and 414 students



actively participated in the seminar. Faculty members, research scholars, and students engaged enthusiastically in interactive sessions focusing on strengthening Indian languages in education and research. The seminar successfully created awareness among participants regarding the importance of Indian languages and their contribution to India's cultural and intellectual heritage.

A guest lecture on "**Basic Knowledge of Measurement in Daily Life**" organized on 3 February 2026 at Krishna Institute of Management and Education. The lecture was conducted to create awareness among students about the importance of measurement in daily life and its practical applications in science, engineering, and routine activities. **Dr. Rajendra Kumar** served as the resource person and explained various concepts of measurement, including standard units, accuracy, consistency, and their role in scientific calculations such as distance, temperature, and volume. Through practical examples and interactive discussion, students gained better understanding of measurement techniques and their everyday relevance. The session was highly interactive, with students actively asking questions and participating in discussions. The lecture helped strengthen students' scientific understanding and encouraged them to apply measurement principles in daily life situations. A total of 49 students participated in the program. The event concluded with a vote of thanks to the resource person and the organizing committee for conducting the informative session successfully.

**The Industry–Academia Integration and Skill Development Cell of Sanatan Dharm College, Muzaffarnagar**, successfully organized an expert lecture on February 26, 2026, titled "The AI ERA: A Smart Assistant Works 24x7." The program featured Dr. Ravindra Kumar Saini, a Professor at Haridwar University, as the resource person. A total of 36 students and 7 teaching staff members attended the session, which was designed to familiarize participants with the emerging role of Artificial Intelligence in education, industry, and daily life. ## Action Taken Report of Best Practices for Odd Semester

The institution has actively implemented various initiatives under the signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) to strengthen academic collaboration, professional development, and entrepreneurial awareness among students.

Under the MoU with **GNIOT Group of Institutions, Greater Noida**, activities related to faculty exchange and academic collaboration were initiated. Faculty members participated in academic discussions, seminars, and knowledge-sharing sessions. Students benefited from expert lectures and collaborative learning opportunities aimed at enhancing academic exposure and interdisciplinary interaction.

As part of the MoU with the **Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI)** for academic exchange, career awareness, skill development, and professional education, several awareness programs and workshops were organized during 2025. Students were informed about professional career opportunities in commerce, accounting, taxation, and finance. Skill enhancement sessions focusing on communication, professional ethics, and employability were also conducted with the support of ICAI resource persons.
